## Sketching Supply List

What I am listing here are my own favorite tools for sketching. Please know this is only to get you acquainted with what works for me. I have found there is no magic brush or paint and what you are most comfortable with is most likely the best tool to use.

**Palette:** You can use either a studio palette or a folding travel palette.

Permanent Green Yellowish (MaimeriBlu) or Green Gold (Daniel Smith)

New Gamboge (Winsor & Newton)

Raw Sienna (Winsor & Newton)

Quinacridone Gold (Daniel Smith or Winsor & Newton)

Winsor Orange (Winsor & Newton)

Scarlet Lake (Winsor & Newton or Holbein)

Permanent Carmine (Holbein or Winsor & Newton)

Rose Violet (Holbein)

Cobalt Violet Light (Holbein)

Ultramarine Light (Maimeri Blu)

Cobalt Blue (Holbein or Winsor & Newton)

Marine Blue (Holbein)

Manganese Blue Hue (Winsor & Newton)

Cobalt Teal Blue (Daniel Smith)

Cupric Green Deep (Maimeri Blu)

Quinacridone Sienna (Daniel Smith)

Burnt Sienna (Winsor & Newton or Daniel Smith)

Lunar Black (Daniel Smith) used for texture

**Brushes:** Loew-Cornell (Ultra Rounds) synthetic hair brushes.

Rounds size 6 to 14 and flats size ½ inch and 1 inch and ¼ inch flat stiff oil painting brush for lifting techniques.

**Niji Waterbrush:** (optional) this brush has a hollow handle for a water reservoir. When squeezed the water comes to the tip of the brush. Great for small, quick watercolor sketches.

**Watercolor Sketchbook:** Aquabee Super Deluxe 808, Arches or Canson. Look for sketchbooks with paper dense enough to handle washes of color without warping or bleeding through.

**Watercolor Paper:** Arches, Bockingford or any 140lb watercolor paper you prefer. Bring several ¼ sheets.

**Drawing Pad:** Canson or Strathmore 11x14 (not newsprint)

**Waterproof Pens:** Pitt or Micron.

**Water-soluble pens:** Tombow or any brand with 2 tips. Generally one end has a stiff “nib” for drawing and the other end has a brush tip. I prefer colors that are more neutral (sepia and gray) as they blend into the paint nicely.

**Pencils:** HB, 2B or 4B pencil.

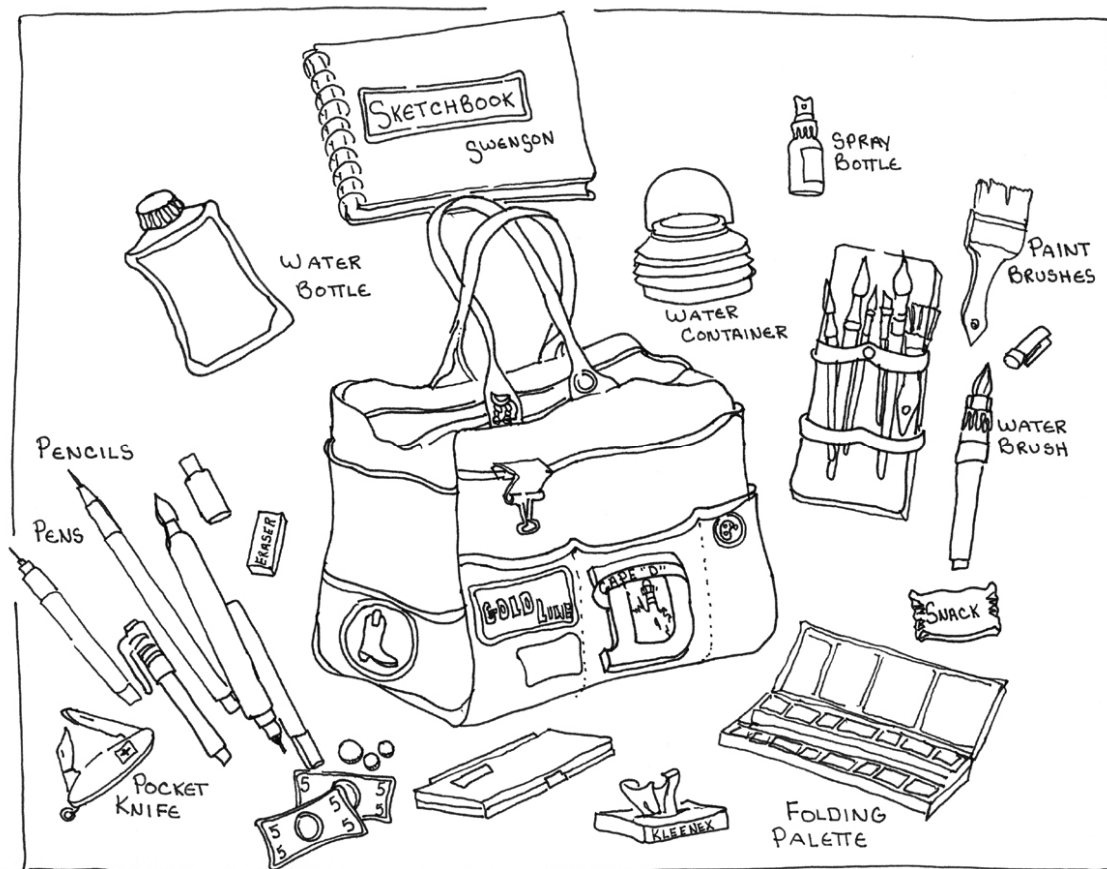
**Erasers:** Kneaded or white eraser.

**Miscellaneous Items:** Watercolor board to support paper, paper towels for clean up, water container and spray bottle.

**Reference Material:** Bring a variety of visual material that inspires you such as vacation photos, sketches, old paintings, travel snap shots...

\* Please bring props to first session. These items will be used for warm-up exercises each morning. Bring items such as silk flowers & fruit, vases, bottle, hand tools ... Please do not bring anything precious that you are unwilling to share.
